LOCATION - LYON IS:



- a city located in the east-central <u>France</u>. It is a half way between sea and mountains and between Paris and Marseille. It is situated about 470 kilometres from Paris and 320 km from Marseille.
- the capital of the Rhône-Alpes region and it belongs to the Rhône department which is the second level of administrative divisions on the map of France.
- divided into 9 municipal arrondissements. Each of them is identified by a number and it has its own council and town hall.
- a city of two rivers which run through it. "La Saône" comes from the North-East of France and "le Rhône" comes from Switzerland to the Mediterranean Sea. They meet in Lyon and merger. They form a peninsula which is called Lyon Presqu'île.

BASIC NUMBERS ABOUT LYON:

- Lyon has 1.4 million inhabitants (+5%)
- Lyon's urban area population is **2.2 million**
- Lyon's area is 47.87 km2
- Lyon is a city with **15,000 new businesses** every year
- Lyon is the 3rd largest city in France (after Paris and Marseille)
- Lyon has an airport (115 destinations and 8.4 million passengers)
- Lyon is a city with 80 new companies being set up yearly
- Lyon is a city with 144 500 students (10% international students) yearly
- Lyon is a city with 4 000 restaurants and 15
 Michelin-starred restaurants

- Lyon has 3 million visitors to the Festival of Lights every year
- Lyon is in the Top 10 European cities for its attractiveness
- Lyon is the **3rd destination** of international travelers in France
- Lyon is the 1st city in Europe for a « city break » The Telegraph 2014 and the 3rd favorite destination for international travelers – TripAdvisor 2014

MAIN FACTS ABOUT LYON AND LYONNAIS:

- Lyon has been created in 43 BC when the Romans arrived. It become Romans second only to Rome in importance city.
- The newly created Lyon had been named the Lugdunum which means the 'city of light'.
- Lyon is known for its historical and architectural landmarks monuments are registered on the **UNESCO World Heritage Site** for example: Vieux Lyon.
- Lyon is known and famous for its silk production.
- Lyon is the French capital of gastronomy (it has the Pope of French Cuisine <u>Paul Bocuse</u> and other gastronomes like <u>Colette</u>
 <u>Sibilia</u> and the 'Lyonnais mothers/'Les mères lyonnaise').
- Only Lyon has "bouchons" (traditional Lyonnais restos very popular, serving homemade food a lot and tasty).
- Lyon was a home of **Antoine de Saint-Exupéry** the French writer who wrote Little Prince. He lived at the Bellecour.
- Lyon is the birthplace of cinema. It was <u>Auguste</u> and <u>Louis Lumière</u>, who invented the cinematographe.
- Economically, Lyon is a major centre for banking, chemical, pharmaceutical, and biotech industries. The GDP of Lyon is 62 billion euro. It makes Lyon the second richest French city after Paris.
- Lyon has a good **location for international organisations** therefore the headquarters of <u>Interpol</u>, <u>Euronews</u> and <u>International</u> <u>Agency for Research on Cancer</u> are situated in the city.



LEISURE ACTIVITIES - TOP 10 THINGS TO DO IN LYON:

- 1. <u>Parc de la Tête d'Or</u> the 'green lungs' of Lyon, the impressive & huge park beloved by everyone with it's free to enter Botanic Garden and free to enter ZOO.
- 2. <u>Vieux Lyon</u> the unmissable place you have to visit in Lyon! It is a charming area full of small streets, typical Lyonnais bouchons, boulangeries, many places to get the best ice cream ever!
- 3. <u>Croix Rousse</u> a bit hidden area of Lyon, only recently started to be appreciated by tourists. It has a unique atmosphere and the opportunity to have a proper tour of the silk history of Lyon by visiting more traboules.
- 4. <u>Confluence district</u> very modern part, located where Saône and Rhône with Confluence Museum and Confluence shopping centre
- 5. <u>Musée des Confluences -</u> this is the must. It is the latest and newest and the most modern museum so impressive with its spaceship shape.
- 6. <u>Musée des Beaux-Arts</u> the Fine Arts Museum which is a true feast for art lovers but not only. It is considered the next-best fine arts museum in France after the Louvre






LEISURE ACTIVITIES - TOP 10 THINGS TO DO IN LYON:

- **7. Fourvière Hill** with the most beautiful church- the Basilique Notre Dame de Fourviere, Gallo-Roman amphitheatre, beautiful park on the Fourviere Hill and the best view of the city! You can get to the Fourviere Hill 2 ways: walking or taking the funicular Lyon. It's a great and fun ride up! Walking is also rewarding yet tiring and longer
- 8. **Rue de la République** the most famous shopping street in Lyon, ideal for shopping as well as exploring the main points of interest in Lyon: **the Palais de la Bourse et du Commerce** in the renaissance architectural style, **Eglise Saint-Bonaventure** which is the former Franciscan church built in the 14th-15th centuries, **the Place des Jacobins** has impressive fountain in the center created by Gaspard André in 1885 etc
- 9. <u>The big square of Place Bellecour</u> located in so-called **Presqu'ile district** between the Rhône and Saône Rivers with the statue of Louis XIV. and <u>Hôtel-Dieu de Lyon</u> building.
- 10. <u>Marche de Creation</u> this is like an outdoor 'Art Gallery', only on Sunday mornings. But also an impressive, old style covered marketplace with over 50 different shops and restaurants <u>Les Halles de Lyon Paul Bocuse</u> and the open food market- <u>Marche</u> <u>Alimentaire Saint Antoine Celestins</u>.

TOP 5 TRIPS AROUND LYON:

- 1. <u>Grenoble</u> it is another big city located 90 kilometers south of Lyon. Even if you cannot compare it with our big Lyon, it is worth visiting. Get your free brochure <u>here</u> and plan your litte visit.
- 2. <u>Oingt</u> it's about 25 kilometers from Lyon and located in the Beaujolais vineyards of the Rhone-Alps region. This is a beautiful village which has been awarded a title of <u>'the most beautiful village of France</u>' in the 2007.
- 3. <u>Parc de Courzieu</u> is just about 21 kilometers from Lyon, it's Animal Park with wolves, eagles, owls and ... snails. Check my memories from here
- 4. <u>Parc de Oiseaux</u> is located about 35 kilometers from Lyon and it is one of the oldest ornithological parks in France. It has a collection of more than 3,000 birds of 300 species from around the world which are accommodated in the area of 380 ha
- 5. <u>La Demeure du Chaos</u> located 15 mins away from Lyon, this is a real museum of the modern art, created by the businessmen sculptor Thierry Ehrmann who has transformed his house 17th century post building into a replica (post-)war zone called Abode of Chaos. It is an open-air art museum with it's 3,609 works, reflecting our tragic or magnificent century as seen by the artist.

TOP 5 MUSEUMS AROUND LYON:

- 1. <u>Maison des Canuts</u>; House of Canuts; 10-12 rue d'Ivry; Open daily from 10 am to 6:30 pm, except on Sundays. Maison des Canuts in La Croix Rousse is a place where you will find out the real story of Lyon silk-making.
- 2. <u>Musée Gadagne</u>; Gadagne Museum; 1 place du Petit-Collège; Open: Wednesday to Sunday from 11am to 6.30pm. Closed on Mondays and Tuesdays! Gadagne is a place where you discover the history of Lyon.
- 3. <u>Musée d'Art Contemporain</u>; Modern Art Museum; 81 quai Charles-de-Gaulle; Open: Wednesday to Sunday: 11am 6pm. Closed on Mondays and Tuesdays! It is located in the Cité Internationale. It is a place where on top of the permanent collection of over 1,100 works of modern art it regularly displayed interesting temporary exhibitions. It has been founded in the 1984 and represents one of Europe's largest collections of modern art.
- 4. <u>Musée des Beaux-Arts</u>; Fine Arts Museum of Lyon; Palais Saint-Pierre, 20 place des Terreaux, 69001 Lyon; Open daily except Tuesdays 10:00 am to 6:00 pm. It is one of the biggest French museums and the must be visited Lyonnais museum.
- 5. <u>Musée des Confluences</u>, Confluences Museum, 86 Quai Perrache, 69002 Lyon; Open: Tuesday to Sunday: 11am -7pm and until 10pm on Thursday. Closed on Mondays! The newest and the most modern.

- 1. <u>Nuits de Fourvières</u> the most popular and famous music festival which takes place on the open air, at my favourite place in Lyon in the roman theatre on the Fourvière Hill.
- <u>La Fête des Lumières</u> truly unmissable & truly the best! Happening every year in December to pay respects to the Virgin Mary!
- 3. Top **FAIRS** which are happening in Lyon every year. For example: <u>Independent Wine-Growers Fair</u>; **The Salon du Chocolat**; **Salon Gourmets & Vins** etc.
- 4. **CINEMATIC** which is the annual film festival created in the respects to the Lumiere Brothers and the origins of the cinematography! It takes place in October and gathers many famous celebrities.
- 5. Lastly also a group of other very good but **SMALLER EVENTS** which I highly recommend!


